STATION 1 - HEADQUARTERS
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Vice Chairperson James Ostrowski called the June 15, 2010, special meeting of Clinton Area Fire & Rescue to order at 7:10 P.M. at Station 1, 2761 N US-27, St Johns, MI 48879, with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Members present James Ostrowski & Gary Hufnagel, Bingham; Gary Hyde & Julie Havens, Greenbush; Duane Ginther & Warren Malkin, Victor, Chief Rosekrans, six citizens.

Ostrowski stated Bingham Township could not afford the service of Clinton Area Fire & Rescue; and would have to have a new agreement, however the service is first class. Bingham Township has a one mil renewal on their August election ballot.

Greenbush Township and Victor Township has passed resolutions extending the existing agreement ten years.

Some items Bingham would like to see changed in the new agreement are:

- Representation on the board
- MFR Budget
- Run Formula – Acts of God
- Management
- Station Lease

Harold (Skip) Starling, Consultant with National Fire Services Office who worked on our ISO rating, stated that Bingham Township's rating would change and that CAFR would have to notify them that Bingham was no longer with Clinton Area Fire & Rescue.

Residents of Bingham Township stated they would help in the passing of the millage.

It was suggested that a member of each township: Michelle Wilsey, Victor, Helen Kus, Bingham, and Julie Havens, Greenbush work as a committee to work out the needs of each township towards a new agreement.

Hufnagel moved, second by Malkin to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:18.
